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'I need to talk' Post Box – Not Immediate Risk




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- Use the post box positioned by the window on the Attendance Office for students to post 'I need to talk to someone' slips.
- These slips are available from the attendance office.
- Students can also add their own pieces of paper.
- **The post box should only be used in a non emergency situation.**
- This does not replace students being instantly able to speak to any adult in school.

Do you need to talk to someone or tell someone something that you are worried or concerned about?

There are numerous ways that you can report safeguarding concerns:

- Speak to **any** member of staff in school. *It is important that you do this as soon as possible if there is serious risk of harm.*
- Speak with Safeguarding staff on duty at break-times in blue high-viz jackets
- Use the 'I need to talk' post box located on the end of the Attendance Office.
- Attend a Safeguarding drop-in session
- Access **The Student Voice** platform

The Student Voice* gives you a platform to share information about how safe you feel within school and in the local area and the ability to anonymously report concerns that will be actioned and responded to appropriately by our Safeguarding and Pastoral Teams. 

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All school PCs and Chromebooks (including those at home) are monitored by SENSO for your safety.

Your I.T teachers are also able to view your screens during lessons.

There are a list of words that when typed into school devices, triggers a warning message to be sent to I.T. helpdesk and the safeguarding team.

Please do not be concerned if a member of the safeguarding team speaks to you about this. This is to make sure that you are safe.


Also please consider that wasting the safeguarding teams time by typing certain words, multiple times is also tracked. This stops students who really need support from getting it.

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Assemblies

- Every week students receive a safeguarding assembly.
- This is delivered by a Senior Leader or your Director of Achievement
- Every week there is a different focus.
- If necessary, we change the focus linked to current safeguarding issues.
- Topics covered include: Online safety, mental health, knife crime, county lines, substance abuse and young carers
- School staff are trained on the assembly focus as well.
