# Launch of Our New Bulwell Pledge System & Champions of Learning Trust

# The Bulwell Pledge System

At the end of the academic year, we will host a celebratory awards ceremony where students who have achieved Bronze, Silver, or Gold will be presented with a badge and certificate.
