Eligibility:

Any significant poor behaviour or poor attendance shown between now and the end of exams may result in your child's invitation being revoked. **To attend prom, your child must have:**

- A high positivity ratio, which can be checked on Kickboard.
- Must attend all exams, on time.
- High attendance and punctuality to school.
- High attendance to exam masterclasses and intervention sessions.

To support our students and encourage them in the final push to their exams, we will be resetting their positivity ratio after Easter. This will give everyone a fresh start and everyone the chance to earn a place at the prom!

When: Wednesday 2 July, starting at 7.00pm (with arrival from 6.30pm) and finishing at 11.00pm.

Cost: £30, payable on Arbor. However, students are being offered the opportunity to earn a

discount on the full price in exchange for their commitment to attending Year 11 Success sessions. Any discount earned will be refunded through Arbor after the end of the exam

period and prior to the Prom.



To receive a free ticket, students must have a combination of some of the criteria below.

- 100% attendance to exam masterclasses
- 100% attendance to school
- 100% punctuality
- High positivity ratio
- High attendance to after school intervention

Included:

The event includes a free mocktail on arrival, a buffet, photo booth, disco and some surprise treats! Students will require funds to buy further soft drinks (cash or card payment at the bar), although there will be a supply of squash and water available to drink with the buffet. We have also arranged for the school photographer to attend the prom to capture the events of the evening.
