### **GCSE Geography Field Trip to Holderness Coast - 30 April 2025**

A Geography fieldwork visit to the Holderness Coast (Bridlington and Hornsea) has been arranged for Year 11 GCSE Geography students on **Wednesday 30 April 2025**.

The day's visit aims to study the characteristics of that coastline. The information obtained will form a valuable source of field research, which will be used as the main source of primary background material for one of the GCSE exams.

The basic details of the visit are as follows:

**Cost:** Funded by the Academy. The Humanities department funds all worksheets and other resources.

**Clothing:** Academy uniform is not required. However, sensible shoes and warm clothing for wet/cold weather are essential.

**Food:** Students should bring a packed lunch and a water bottle. For students in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided, if required.

**Date & Time:** The trip will depart from The Bulwell Academy at **7:30am** on **Wednesday 30 April 2025** and return by **6:30pm** on the same day.
