Our Parents Advisory Group (PAG) is a group of parents, carers, and family members of students of The Bulwell Academy.

The group meets three times per year to provide advice, information, and support to the Academy, providing insight and support to enable the highest quality education for our pupils.

Each Year Group is represented by at least two parents.

The Group's objectives are:

- To support the school in achieving its targets in:
 - Effectiveness of leadership and management
 - Quality of teaching, learning, and assessment
 - Personal development, behaviour, and welfare
 - Outcomes for students.
- To contribute to the school's effectiveness.
- To enable decisions made by the leadership team of the school to be well-informed.
- To provide a connection between the school and community and enable an Academy-Parent-Student team approach.
- To enable parental feedback to the school, in the confidence that their feedback will be used in a positive way.
- To advise on ways in which learning opportunities can be enriched in the school.
- To raise any concerns about the school or its students with the Principal or senior staff.
- To have a say in the development of school policies.

Terms of Reference:

The PAG will meet three times each year to discuss Academy performance, policies and approaches towards development.

PAG members will operate in strict confidence; however, agreed outcomes will be shared with the Governing Body, parents and staff.

Parents who do not attend 3 consecutive meetings will be considered to have withdrawn from the Group.
