**The Bulwell Academy Year 11 Graduation Prom, Thursday 4 July 2024
The Belfry Hotel, Mellors Way, Off Woodhouse Way NG8 6PY**



One of the highlights of the Academy year for our Year 11 students is the Graduation Prom. It is an evening of high glamour, fun and celebration to recognise the hard work and commitment by our students and we hope that your child will be able to attend.

The invitation to the Prom is a reward for your child's positive education at The Bulwell Academy.

We want all students to come and enjoy the prom, but this reward must be earned!

Eligibility: Any significant poor behaviour or poor attendance shown between now and the end of exams may result in your child's invitation being revoked. Your child must complete at least one Success Passport (ie, attend at least 10 Success sessions) between now and the end of exams.

When: Thursday 4 July, starting at 7.00pm (with arrival from 6.30pm) and finishing at 11.00pm.

Where: The Belfry Hotel, Mellors Way, Off Woodhouse Way.

Cost: £30, payable on ParentPay. However, students are being offered the opportunity to earn a discount on the full price in exchange for their commitment to attending Year 11 Success sessions*. Students have been given a Success Passport which should be 'stamped' after every Success session (after school and during holidays) in order to gain short term rewards or discounted Prom tickets. Any discount earned will be refunded through ParentPay after the end of the exam period and prior to the Prom.

Included: The event includes a free mocktail on arrival, a buffet, photo booth, photographer and disco. Students will require funds to buy further soft drinks (cash or card payment at the bar), although there will be a supply of squash and water available to drink with the buffet. We have also arranged for the school photographer to attend the prom to capture the events of the evening.



Behaviour: The Bulwell Academy has a zero-tolerance policy on under-age drinking and smoking. Any students found bringing in or drinking alcohol on the premises or smoking will be sent home. We have requested a contact number on the online form for any emergency situations that might arise on the night.
